Many of you may have heard the news regarding Phase 2 of the Restoring Safe Services Plan in Manitoba. That plan included educational announcements. As of today, here is what we know:

- Suspension of classes will continue until the end of June,
- Remote learning will wind down by the second week of June,
- All work should be submitted back to your local school no later than June 15,
- Schools will be open to the public as of June 1 and teaching staff will be at schools,
- When entering the school, screening questions will be asked and hand sanitizing must occur. If you are ill or have been exposed to anyone diagnosed with COVID-19 we ask that you please stay home,
- Based on the Limited use of Schools Guidelines from Manitoba Education, school staff can interact with students in the school. These interactions will be by invitation from the school and may include meetings for transition planning, guidance counselling, grad credit checking, and assessment for recovery of learning needs,
- Communication will come from school to home if there is a request to meet,
- Schools will make the arrangements for the return of divisional supplies that have been loaned out during remote learning ie. Computers, class supplies etc.,
- School may begin on August 31, 2020. This is still to be determined by Manitoba Education and the Province of Manitoba,
- Professional Development days in the 2020/2021 school year may be repurposed as school days. This is still to be determined by Manitoba Education.

As we have more up to date information regarding these recently announced items, we will be communicate with the schools and our families.

Please continue to be well and a reminder that as the Province open-up, social distancing and hand washing are still the best defense against COVID-19.
